





- Atlantic Canada's largest port (by volume)


Moncton







Required

Documents

- Identity documents translated in one of Canada's two official languages (passport, birth certificate, national identity card, family record book etc.).
- Education Credential Assessment (ECA): designated organizations
- Language Proficiency Assessment: Language Proficiency Tests accepted by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada
- Work experience validated by letters of reference in required format
