Surface: 71,400 km²

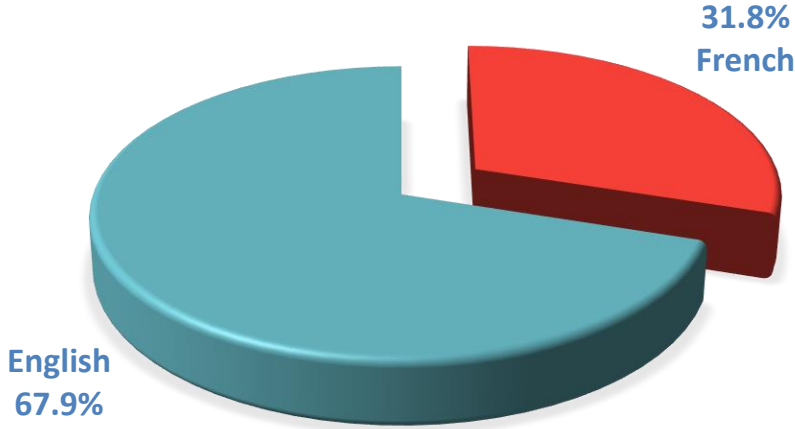

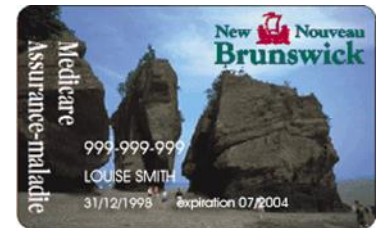

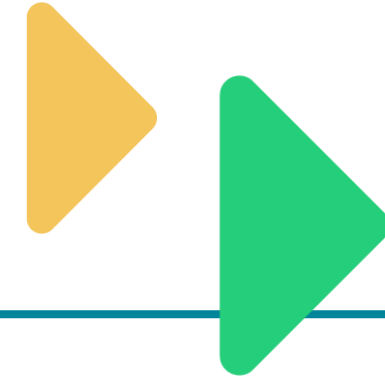
Required

Documents

- ▶ Identity documents translated in one of Canada's two official languages (passport, birth certificate, national identity card, family record book etc.).
- ▶ Education Credential Assessment (ECA) : designated organizations
- ▶ Language Proficiency Assessment: Language Proficiency Tests accepted by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada
- ▶ Work experience validated by letters of reference in required format
